Poster submissions will be peer-reviewed for academic content and interest

Poster application deadline: September 15, 2020; Acceptances notified November 1, 2020

Submit a one-page word document in Word format; no handwritten applications will be accepted.

Guidelines to Complete Original Clinical Research Application

Project Description: The abstract should state the **objective** of the study, the **methods** used/**population demographics, the main findings** (data); **conclusions** and the **relevance** of the studies to others. Max 350 words not counting title or author information

1. Title of project and school or organization name
2. Corresponding Author name/email and phone number
3. Background/Objective of the study
4. Method used (e.g. retrospective chart review; active survey of participants etc.); population and study setting (medical students in classroom, patients in clinic etc.)
5. Main results- summary
6. Conclusions of clinical interest

Guidelines to Complete Educational Endeavor Application

Project Description: The abstract should state the **objective** of the endeavor, the **methods** used/**population demographics of the group in the endeavor**; overall impression of the educational endeavor (what worked well/what could be improved upon in your iteration?) Could this endeavor be turned into a clinical outcomes project in the future? Max 350 words not counting title or author information

1. Title of project and school or organization name
2. Corresponding Author name/email and phone number
3. Background/Objective of the study
4. Method used (e.g. retrospective chart review; active survey of participants etc.); population and study setting (medical students in classroom, patients in clinic etc.)
5. Overall impressions of the endeavor
6. Conclusions of clinical interest

Additionally: Create 150 word or less summary of your poster submission for inclusion in the program for others to review during the conference.
